\$143,700 OTF Grant from the Ontario Government Helps Community Centre's Urban Farm Grow

Ottawa, ON – On Thursday, local MPP Lucille Collard met with the team at the Rideau-Rockcliffe Community Resource Centre (RRCRC) to hear more about the \$143,000 Grow grant from the provincial government's Ontario Trillium Foundation (OTF) that was used to expand its hydroponic leafy greens program. The project will strengthen community food security through locally grown fresh produce.

"This project is a wonderful example of how innovation in urban agriculture can strengthen our communities. By transforming an unused space into a productive indoor farm, the Rideau-Rockcliffe Community Resource Centre is showing what's possible when creativity meets commitment to food security," said Lucille Collard, MPP for Ottawa—Vanier.

Located in the old shop class of a former high school, the \$143,000 grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation has allowed the RRCRC's Social Harvest Program to convert the space from a microgreens growing project to an urban farm that supplies fresh produce for their Emergency Food Bank. The grant made it possible for Social Harvest to improve the equipment for hydroponics, hire staff and ultimately, better support community members in need. This will enhance RRCRC's ability to provide a consistent supply of high-quality fresh produce to food-insecure community members throughout the year. It also will allow the organization to engage more volunteers and program participants, creating valuable opportunities for hands-on learning, skills development, and community connection.

"This grant has played a crucial role in equipping us to meet rising community food needs through innovative urban agriculture," said Maddie LeBlanc, Project Officer of the RRCRC's Social Harvest program. "It has enabled us to acquire the essential equipment needed to transform our hydroponic growing space into a highly productive and efficient facility. With this support, we have significantly expanded our production capacity, strengthened the resilience of our crops, and aligned our growing practices with industry best standards. This project serves as a powerful proof of concept: by transforming a former wood workshop into a thriving indoor farm, we are demonstrating that fresh, nutritious food can be grown efficiently in unconventional spaces."
